Further the undersigned agrees to hold the CTHJA Final Show, the Travis County Exposition Center, Travis County, and CTHJA, their employees, and show management, harmless to lost, destroyed, or stolen property and for any injury to horse, exhibitors, and spectators before, during or after the show.

Dear Central Texas Hunter Jumper Association Members,

Your Central Texas Hunter Jumper Association board is here to serve you, our members of the local horse showing community, and I would like to personally congratulate everyone on another great year. Together we have had wonderful competition and lots of fun!

During our final Summer Circuit show earlier this year, we had a well-attended membership meeting where we discussed ways to keep our organization relevant and our horse shows interesting and fun. As we approach our final horse show of this season, I wanted to inform you of changes to the show this year as well as new and exciting changes to look forward to next year.

Expansion of lower fence height equitation and jumper classes

In response to your requests, we have added a Modified Child/Adult Equitation division and a Schooling Jumper division to our 2011 year-end show schedule.

Rule Change regarding cross entry between 2'6" Medal and Youth Non-Pro over fences classes

Our current rules and regulations do not allow competitors to cross enter between the 2'6" Medal and the Youth Non-Pro over fences classes. Membership agreed that cross entry between these classes should be allowed to encourage developing riders. This rule change was approved and will be effective at the start of the 2012 show season. The new rule will read, "Riders may not cross enter into classes with fence height of 2'9" or higher at the same show, except Youth Non-Pro."

Annual CTHJA Youth Sportsmanship Award and Scholarship

An annual sportsmanship and scholarship award was proposed and discussed. Membership decided to form a committee to develop this concept. The award will recognize junior riders who serve as positive role models for their peers, demonstrate ongoing commitment and dedication to the sport, are involved in their community, and exemplify positive sportsmanship principles. Over the next 6-8 months, the committee will finalize the criteria for the award, selection process and timeline. Applications for the award will be available by late summer for the 2012 show year.

Annual Year-End CTHJA Mini Derby and Horse Show

Membership discussed the idea of developing a CTHJA Mini Derby to be held at the Year End Show and decided to form a committee to expand this concept. The committee will decide on class specifications including course requirements, eligibility, judging system and awards. The committee will also address the impact the derby will have on the overall year end show schedule.

As we look forward to another great year together, I welcome your thoughts and ideas on growing our organization.

RULES & REGULATIONS

TEXAS EQUINE LIABILITY ACT

Central Texas Hunter & Jumper Assoc. Points and Membership All riders participating in Central Texas Hunter & Jumper Assoc. (CenTex) point classes **must** be members in good standing of the Central Texas Hunter & Jumper Association (CTHJA or CenTex). Nonmembers may join online or at the show. Central Texas points will be awarded to all horses/riders participating in recognized classes in accordance with Central Texas Hunter & Jumper Assoc. Rules and Regulations.

Entries The entry fee is \$18.00 for each class, unless otherwise noted in this prize list. Pre-registration requires NO money or obligation.

Numbers can be picked up in the horse show office once **entry fees are paid** (open checks are preferred), **entry blanks are completed** (including signatures), and proof of a current **Coggins has been presented** to Show Secretary (in accordance with State of Texas requirements). Schooling Rings will be open from 2pm-8pm on November 18th. Other times to be announced. Any horse schooling but not showing will be charged a \$25.00 schooling fee.

Accommodations A limited number of camper hook-ups will be available for \$35 per night. Please call ahead to reserve these spaces. Due to safety restrictions, electrical outlets will be locked and office must be notified to grant access.

Stabling 10' x 10' box stalls with doors are available for \$65.00. Shavings may be purchased at the show. No horse may remain on the grounds overnight without renting a stall. Any horse showing and not renting a stall will be charged a \$25.00 grounds fee.

Attire Riders must be appropriately attired. **Riding coats ARE required. All exhibitors must wear headgear in accordance with U.S. Equestrian rule GR318.** A polo shirt with collar or riding shirt without coat may be worn ONLY in jumper classes.

Scheduling Classes and divisions may be cancelled, moved, split or combined at management's discretion due to volume of entries, weather or other factors affecting timely completion of the show. Management reserves the right to require exhibitors to ride in the posted order of go and implement the one minute rule. Should posted order of go become effective, order will be posted at least one hour prior to start of the class.

Judge's Decisions are Final All judge's decisions are final. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges, show officials or employees, or fellow exhibitors on the part of an owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees.

Awards A trophy and six ribbons will be awarded in all classes. All Hunter and Jumper division Champion and Reserve Champion titles will be awarded in accordance with current USEF Rules. Jump-offs for first place only. Ties for all other places will be determined by the fastest time in the first round among those with equal faults. Ties for Champion and Reserve Champion will remain tied.

Concessions Concessions are available on the show grounds on show days.

MODIFIED CHILDREN/ADULT EQUITATION DIVISION

Fences: 2'6". Open to non-professional junior and adult amateur riders. The rider may not compete at the same show in classes 3' or higher. **This division will be cancelled or moved if necessary to run the show in a timely manner.**

SPECIAL BEGINNER RIDER EQUITATION DIVISION

MEDAL FINALS

Qualifying riders (all winners plus top five point earning non-winners) will be notified, please check CTHJA.COM for most current updates. No rider may compete in both the CenTex and 2'6" Medal Finals, even if they qualified for both.

CENTEX MEDAL FINAL

Fences: 3'-3'3". Open to all junior and adult amateur riders. To be ridden over a course of at least eight fences with at least two changes of direction and an in-and-out. Mandatory work-off will test at least the top four riders from the first round. USEF Tests 1-19 (Section EQ113) may be used.

Class 72. Centex Medal

No entry fee

CENTEX 2'6" MEDAL FINAL

Fences: 2'6". Open to all junior and adult amateur riders. Riders MAY cross-enter in classes with fence heights of 2'9" or higher at this show ONLY. Mandatory work-off will test at least the top four riders from the first round. USEF Tests 1-9 (Section EQ113) may be used.
